5. Vehicle Nuisance

- 5.1. DH advised that it was now proposed to install barriers permanently on Course Road and that he hoped that the Parish Council would agree to provide flower baskets to improve the entrance to Course Road.
- 5.2. Taxi ranks had yet to be installed at Rocksalt and Bar 1. DH has been advised that a consultation would take place in the next 6 weeks.
- 5.3. The drop off and pick up of pupils from Cheapside School remains an issue. A car park on Crown Estate land has been discounted on the grounds of cost but it was suggested that a kiss and drop are might be established on the western verge of Watersplash Lane. This land is owned partly by RBWM and partly by Bracknell Forest.
- 5.4. A discussion took place on the incident when a student of Charters School was hit by a car. MW and JP stated that this was not the driver's fault but the girl stepped out into the road. Amongst pupils the narrow footways are perceived to be dangerous and there is no surprise when this type if incident occurs. It was agreed to look at the vegetation growing through the railings to see if this could be cut back and to check if the footway could be widened adjacent to the School playing fields.

6. ASB

- 6.1. The issues at 24 Greenways Drive were reported to have quietened down and no more complains had been received from local residents.
- 6.2. LY reported a number of incidents that had occurred on Victory Field including a Portaloo being burnt to the ground. She also mentioned 3 spates of graffiti with Nazi signs and eggs being thrown at the home of an Asian family.

6.3. ASB has been reported in Carroll Crescent including damaging cards and throwing bricks. The police were called but residents were told that there were no police available. When a resident dialled 101 it took 45 minutes for the all centre to answer. The police have CCTV footage of the incident and police action is awaited.

6.4. GW reported an incident in River Street Car Park in Windsor where a vagrant was advising parkers of a password that allowed them to leave without paying. The vagrant received thanks in the way of gratuities from those who did not pay.
