3. Representations from Alain-Marcos Basurto de Castillon

3.1. Disabled parking

3.1.1. Marcos raised concerns over the build out on the eastern side of Course Road that has displaced the Disabled Parking bay and the fact that the post that supports the Disabled Bay sign is located at the point where a car door would be opened preventing easy entry to the vehicle. Marcos agreed to contact Neil Walter the Council's Parking Manager.

3.1.2. A discussion took place on NSL the Council's parking enforcement contractor. Marcos stated that NSL do attend in Ascot but not that frequently.
