## **2. Minutes from meeting of Monday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020**

## **3. Matters arising**

3.1. Engagement with Younger people; AS stated that Berkshire Community Youth Project presented to the Parish Conference. One of the opportunities the suggested was youth busses that come equipped with games etc. The cost of a bus for two hours was indicated to be £175.00 but RS would check to see if this might be cheaper for the police. It was agreed that the key to success would be the ability to engage.

3.2. DH advised that he had discussed engagement with the 6<sup>th</sup> Form at Charters and RD said she would contact the Head of the 6<sup>th</sup> Form.

## **4. Priorities 2019 all figures for the period 1<sup>st</sup> December to 9<sup>th</sup> March**

### **4.1. Burglary Residential:**

- 30 dwelling burglaries took place in the area. This equates to 10 a month which set against previous statistics is high.

### **4.2. Burglary non dwelling:**

- There were 9 thefts from business premises and 7 thefts from sheds

### **4.3. Theft from Motor Vehicle:**

- Five vehicles were stolen during the period.

### **4.4. Vehicle Nuisance**

- VP advised that the speed gun was available for Speed Watch campaigns but members of the public would need to be trained and there was a concern about the safety of those who carry our speed watch

### **4.5. ASB**

Very few issues are reported to the Sunninghill and Ascot Parish Office except an occasional incidence of graffiti.

## **5. Neighbourhood Watch**

5.1. VP stated that Windsor and Ascot NW have set up a Facebook page and so far, have 2,000+ hits. The NW are working to set up new groups and re-energise existing groups. They are working on a security survey with the Thames Valley Police and assisted by PCSOs will train volunteers how to carry the survey out.

5.2. In a general discussion on the management of speeding traffic RD advised that the SID could be booked and traffic surveys are carried out by the Project Centre on behalf of RBWM.

## 6. General

6.1. RS stated the police continue to carry out clear car campaigns.

6.2. AS suggested that the police could attend both the Street Fair and Party in the in the Park. In the past the police cadets have supported the street fair.

6.3. RD stated that it would be possible to book the Mounted police.
