

# **Ascot, Cheapside, Sunninghill, South Ascot and Sunningdale Neighbourhood Action Group.**

**Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021**

## **1. Attendance:**

## **2. Minutes from meeting of Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021**

### **2.1. Matters arising**

- MR agreed to arrange a presentation to Charters students on drug awareness including County Lines but that this would be done after students returned to school.
- Further discussion took place on funding an ANPR camera for the A30 in Sunningdale. MR stated that there was a need to liaise with Surrey Police on the most appropriate location. The cost would be around £10K. Some funding was available from monies previously held by the now disbanded Neighbourhood Watch and it was hoped that Sunningdale Parish Council could contribute.
- DH still to establish process for reporting footways where growth has reduced the width.

## **3. Priorities 2019 all figures for the period 1<sup>st</sup> January to 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021**

### **3.1. Burglary Residential:**

- There were nil dwelling burglaries in the area. This is the first occasion in the 12 years that the NAG has been running that this has happened.

### **3.2. Burglary non dwelling:**

- Shed / outbuilding breaks nil.
- For the third month no commercial / business burglaries

### **3.3. Theft from and theft of Motor Vehicles:**

- There was one theft from a motor vehicle.

### **3.4. Vehicle Nuisance**

- There were no reports of speeding.

## **4 ASB**

- A general concern was raised on young people ignoring the social isolation rules.
- It was reported that there had been some youths hanging around Broomhall park and not socially isolating.
- TW stated that 18/19-year-old youths had been seen in the Victory Field tennis courts that were closed because of Covid-19. HG said that some had broken through the barriers around the skate park and became abusive when challenged.
- MR advised that despite the gates being locked about 30 youths has cut railings to gain access to the skate park at Vansittart Road.

- TW advised the meeting that she could not issue fixed penalty notices for dog fouling.

5 **General**

- MR described an incident on Sunningdale Golf Course when having lost sight of her dog, a dog walker turned a corner to see an individual with her dog between his legs appearing to check its teeth. Her conclusion was that he was considering stealing the dog. MR advised people to be wary as dog theft was on the increase.
- VP advised that the quality of recordings from video door bells had improved to the point where recordings could be used as evidence. This had led to a reduction in burglaries and were a positive security device. Issue around GDPR and sharing the videos was discussed.
